If you are a health professional working in an underserved area of Alameda County, have outstanding educational debt, and meet other important application criteria related to cultural and linguistic competency, you may be eligible to apply. <u>Please carefully review the eligibility guidelines for the program to which you are interested in applying</u>.

Eligible sites include publicly funded or public mental health facilities, non-profit mental health facilities that contract with a county entity to provide mental health services, and/or designated mental health professions shortage areas.

An awardee may receive up to \$15,000 to repay educational loans for not less than a 12-month commitment practicing and providing direct client care in an eligible site. Applicants can be awarded up to three (3) times.
