

ACBH Announces Launch of #By Your Side Campaign for Substance Use Continuum

Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Services (ACBH) is pleased to announce the upcoming launch of an 8-week social and print media campaign to promote awareness of and access to Alameda County's drug and alcohol prevention and treatment services. In April the #ByYourSide campaign will launch on several popular social media platforms, as well in search engines such as Google. In May and June, print media assets such as bus advertisements, brochures, press releases, and other resources will launch.

The campaign is designed to reach people who may feel the social stigma and shame associated with drug and alcohol addiction. The messages aim to highlight our system as a safe place to work on recovery, free from judgement. Providers strive to accompany people in their own journeys to wellness, health, and recovery.

Substance Use Access & Referral Helpline 1-844-682-7215 is the community's front-door access to all services in the drug and alcohol treatment and prevention system. Callers will be screened and referred to an appropriate program based on their self-identified needs.
