Re: Distribution of ACBHCS's Member Handbook and Provider Lists

Pursuant to the **Federal Code of Regulations Title 42** and California State Department of Mental Health requirements, ACBHCS has implemented the policy, ***"Distribution of ACBHCS's Member Handbook and Provider Lists."***

Although you may have previously received a copy of the policy, we have enclosed an additional copy for your convenience. For organizational providers, we recommend that you maintain a copy of the policy in the "Miscellaneous Section" of the **Quality Assurance Manual**. For independent practitioners, we recommend that you maintain a copy of the policy in your **Provider Handbook**.

In order to implement this policy, we have enclosed a copy of the ACBHCS Member Handbook (English), ACBHCS Provider List and ACBHCS Member Handbook Poster.

The policy states:

"An ACBHCS Member Handbook, along with its provider list, will be provided to all beneficiaries when the first specialty mental health service is rendered and upon request to the agency rendering the service."

Since the CA State DMH will be providing the materials to existing beneficiaries via mail, **it is not necessary to provide these materials to beneficiaries presently enrolled in services unless it is requested.**
