

Lockout Situations

Lockout Situations: A “lockout” means that a service activity is not reimbursable through Medi-Cal because the beneficiary resides in and/or receives mental health services in one of the settings listed below. A staff may provide services within their scope of practice, but it would not be reimbursable.
