BACKGROUND:

The Clinical Quality Review Team functions to review clinical records for documented evidence of medical and service necessity for mental health services and to authorize services. Reviewers work together with other providers in providing oversight to their clinical charts. This is accomplished through identifying documentation issues, making recommendations for corrective actions, and providing positive feedback.

REGISTER:

All contracted Community Based Organizations are invited to register their QA or Training staff, Clinical Supervisor(s), Management staff, or Administration- 2 seats per Agency. This is not a “line staff” training.
