Target Audience: Alameda County Behavioral Health (ACBH) contracted providers advise of changes to the SMHS Mental Health Assessment process and template for children and youth ages 0-21. Provider QA leads, clinical supervisors, and clinical staff are all strongly recommended to attend.

Description: Effective March 7th, 2022, ACBH providers must conduct individualized determinations of each child's/youth's need for ICC, IHBS, and TFC, based on the child/youth's strengths and needs. Individualized determinations of need for ICC, IHBS, and TFC must be documented in the child/youth's Specialty Mental Health Assessment. Such services, if appropriate, should also be included in the Client Plan.
