Description:

- *Effective January 1, 2021, the American Medical Association's (AMA) CPT® Professional Manual changed the requirements for selecting the "E/M Office, or Other Outpatient, Services" (CPT® Codes 99201 – 99205, and 99211 – 99215)*
- *Effective March 1, 2021, this will impact Alameda County Behavioral Health (ACBH) Qualified health Providers (QHP), which include Physicians (MD, DO), Advanced Practice Nurses (NP, CNS) and Physician Assistants (PA) who claim for medication management services with these CPT® E/M codes*
- *The training will include a summary of the changes. Note, the training will focus on providers who are submitting claims to Medi-Cal either through Clinician's Gateway (CG) or InSyst*
- ***Note:** Clinical Pharmacists (CP) have their own Medication Therapy Management Service (MTMS) codes which will not be addressed in this training.*
