- Child & Young Adult Programs -

Counseling-Enriched Special Day Class (CESDC)

Liaise directly with school district on family willingness to access insurance plans

School-Based Behavioral Health (SBBH)

May serve up to 4 ERMHS clients/yr at public school sites

- Only serve students attending school at sites identified in Exhibit A-SOW
 - Direct other children/youth to other BH programs/ACCESS
- 12-month programs, including services during summer/breaks
- More standardization in hours (8:30-5), where possible, while school is in session
 - Note issues in your input form and we can include exceptions in Exhibit A-SOWs
- Services may be rendered in homes and other field-based locations



Exhibit A-P: MH New Content - Child & Young Adult Programs -

Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS)

Referrals must be accompanied by a treatment plan specific to the client's needs

Katie A./Intensive Care Coordination (ICC) Expansion Services

Authorization from ACBH Katie A./ICC Coordinator for Intensive Home-Based Services (IHBS)



- Full Service Partnerships -

Across Full Service Partnerships (FSPs)

- Continue under the Payment Reform Pilot
- Continue to work with ACBH on development/refinement of measures

> TAY, Adult, Older Adult FSPs

Participate in Individualized Placement and Support (IPS) Learning Collaborative and other TA around IPS



- TAY, Adult & Older Adult Programs -

Service Teams:

- ✤ Assessment within 7 days of any discharge from acute care
- ✤ Work with Collaborative Courts and Adult Forensic Behavioral Health
- Contact ACBH Office of Medical Director for more information on Telehealth/MIA
- Updated Quality Objectives



- TAY, Adult & Older Adult Programs -

Adult Outpatient Therapy (formerly Level III)

- Crisis intervention being added to remaining programs
- Travel for field-based services: now same as other M/C programs

➢ CalWORKs

Individualized Placement and Support (IPS) includes supported employment
 Updated quality benchmarks

➢In-Home Outreach Team (IHOT)

- Clients authorized by ACBH
- CBO staff highly encouraged to attend initial appointments with clients



- Other Program Types -

Integrated Behavioral Health (IBH)

- Use of Community Health Record (CHR) for clients eligible for Care Connect
- More specifics on referral to specialty behavioral health when appropriate

Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI)

MHSA Team will be starting to implement virtual monitoring visits

- Visits will occur every 2 years

Changes to PEI Data and Narrative Reporting

- Changes in reporting frequency for many providers
- Some may not need to be so granular in relation to PEI reporting categories
- Instructions forthcoming about:
 - * Submission of Data Report via portal
 - * New reporting template for Narrative Reports
