## ALAMEDA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES (ACBHCS) HARD TO FILL/RETAIN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA for the STATE MENTAL HEALTH LOAN ASSUMPTION PROGRAM (MHLAP) FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017

ACBHCS applicants must meet the following hard to fill/retain criteria, based on the MHSA Workforce Needs Assessment and priority workforce needs, to be considered eligible for the MHLAP:

### REQUIREMENTS DIRECT CLINICAL SERVICE STAFF

#### **Work Hours**

Must work a minimum of 32 hours per week in a public mental health program.

Psychiatrists must work a minimum of 20 hours per week in a public mental health program.

#### **Employment Status**

Must be employed in an eligible provider role, as identified in the MHLAP application, for a minimum of six (6) months in a permanent position. <sup>1</sup>

#### **Total Weekly Hours of Direct Clinical Service** <sup>2</sup>

Must provide a minimum of 20 hours direct service per week.

Part-time Psychiatrists are exempt from the minimum 20-hour direct service requirement.

#### **Work Location**

Must work within an eligible ACBHCS County-operated mental health setting or a contracted, community-based mental health or co-occurring conditions agency.

Hospital programs and publicly-funded programs administered by adult correctional entities or services provided in adult correctional facilities are not eligible for this program.

#### AND AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

# Providers who are bi-lingual in one of the County's threshold languages and/or who represent the ethnically and culturally diverse communities that ACBHCS serves.

- Bi-lingual in Spanish, Cantonese, Mandarin or Vietnamese and/or
- Have lived experience as a mental health consumer/family member or represent one or more of the following ethnically and culturally diverse communities that ACBHCS serves: African-American, Asian Pacific Islander, Hispanic, Native American, South or Southeast Asian, or LGBTIQQ2-S.

#### OR:

Providers in hard to fill/retain positions or those who possess experience/ expertise in hard to fill/retain skill sets. <sup>3</sup>

- Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioners/Advanced Practice Nurses
- Clinical Psychiatric Pharmacist
- Psychiatrists, especially child psychiatrists
- Providers with integrated primary care/behavioral health care experience/expertise
- Providers who work in programs delivering services to:
  - 1) Older Adult
  - 2) Transitional Age Youth
  - 3) LGBTIQQ2-S
  - 4) Youth in the Juvenile Justice System
  - 5) Clients with Co-Occurring Conditions

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Change of jobs to a different organization during the application review process is cause for disqualification, as it voids the minimum length of time for the employment requirement. However, a change of job with the <u>same</u> organization, serving the <u>same</u> population in a hard to fill/retain position will not disqualify.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Direct Service is defined as: services that generates units of service, opening or closing cases, crisis intervention, assessments, individual /family/group therapy, rehabilitation services, medication evaluation/consultation, integrated behavioral and EBP interventions.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> To receive credit, clearly identify your qualifying program, job functions and direct service hours on the "County Employment or Volunteer Verification" section of the MHLAP application.
