Re: Release of the newly updated MH and SUD Included (aka “Allowed”) Diagnoses Lists and Crosswalks.

---

These updates are required because DHCS recently released their modified Included Diagnoses Lists and because DSM-5 issued additional error corrections.

ALL BHCS and BHCS-Contracted Mental Health (MH) and Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Providers are required to begin using these new diagnoses lists immediately. See attached lists.

As well, the Provider website will be updated with the new lists. See: ACHBCS Provider Website/QA/Audit Notices, Reports & Tools/Audit Tools/Diagnoses Lists and Crosswalks at the following link: <http://www.acbhcs.org/providers/QA/audit.htm>

The lists are broken down by Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder diagnoses. Mental Health is broken into both Outpatient SMHS and Inpatient SMHS.

Further there are two versions of all lists. One is organized alpha by DSM-5 diagnosis name and the second is numeric by ICD-10 code.

Additionally two crosswalks are provided.
