| Subject: | Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) 90-Day Rule and the New BBS-Candidate Designation  |

This memo is to inform providers about a new process **effective April 14, 2025,** that enables Marriage Family Therapists (MFT), Professional Clinical Counselors (PCC) and Clinical Social Work (CSW) candidates who are awaiting their registration numbers from the Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) to submit claims to Medi-Cal as Registered/Associate providers (e.g. AMFT, APCC, ACSW).

# **Background**

Per <u>BHIN 24-023</u>, Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) changed the definition of "registered" providers to include individuals who are *in the process of* obtaining registration as CSW, MFT, and PCC candidates, as well as individuals whose registrations as candidates for these licensure types have been approved by the BBS.

This means that CSW, MFT and PCCs who are in the process of obtaining their registration numbers from the BBS may claim Medi-Cal as registered providers while their associate registration application is being processed and before they have received their registration numbers. However, in the event their application is not approved by BBS, the services provided by these individuals are not Medi-Cal reimbursable.

### **New ACBHD BBS-Candidate Designation**

To accommodate this change, ACBHD has created a new Professional Suffix/License Type of **BBS-Candidate.** This designation provides access to an expanded set of procedure codes allowable for registered providers.

The process for obtaining this designation and detailed requirements are published in a document titled <u>Requesting ACBHD BBS-Candidate Provider Designation</u>. This document is posted in section 12 of the <u>QA Manual</u> on the ACBHD Provider website.
