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Subject: Considerations for Selecting Diagnoses/Codes for Claiming

The purpose of this memo is to announce the publication of a document titled *Considerations for Selecting a Diagnosis for Claiming* and removal of outdated diagnosis resources from the <u>QA Manual</u> page of the ACBHD Provider website.

Background

Effective January 1, 2022, per BHINs 21-073 and 21-075, except for psychiatric inpatient hospital, psychiatric health facility services, and SUD residential/inpatient, DHCS no longer limits SMHS or DMC-ODS to lists of included diagnoses; instead, DHCS provides categorical guidance.

New Resource

Following the DHCS example, ACBHD will no longer publish specific lists of diagnoses/codes. As a result, the following reference guides have been removed from the QA Manual:

- ACBH SMHS OP ICD-10 CM Diagnoses for Claiming
- ACBH SUD OP ICD-10-CM Diagnoses for Claiming
- BHIN 20-043 Enclosure 1-SMHS Inpatient Included Diagnosis
- BHIN 20-074E Enclosure 1- SUD Residential and Inpatient Included Diagnosis

A new document has been created titled <u>Selecting Diagnoses/Codes for Claiming</u> and published in Section 13 of the QA Manual. This ACBHD resource provides information about selecting diagnoses and codes for claiming in the DMC-ODS and SMHS delivery systems. It includes a table summarizing the guidance and requirements from DHCS related to diagnoses codes that may be used for claiming across the systems and levels of care and helpful links to DHCS source material.
