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Request for Interest (RFI) Qualified Psychiatrists – Licensed Psychologist (Issued 5/19/2015)

Intent

Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Services (BHCS) is seeking interest from any entity or entities interested to be included in a pool of qualified psychiatrists and/or licensed clinical psychologists, who can conduct evaluations/assessments for conserving psychiatric patients. On an as-needed basis, BHCS may contact any of the interested parties in the compiled list to perform the below requirements.

Scope of work

Alameda County BHCS will coordinate assessments for conserving psychiatric patients with a selected pool of qualified psychiatrists and/or psychologists. The evaluations/assessments will take place primarily at state hospitals in California, mostly Napa State Hospital and possibly, other State hospitals located in central California or the Los Angeles area. Physicians will be expected to carry insurance and meet all requirements as needed.

Psychiatrist(s) are required to be licensed and board certified, selected from a group of professionals who have experience in performing one-on-one assessments with/on patients in a hospital setting and experience working with forensic patients. The services include: perform evaluations, write assessments, may require some limited consultation with hospital staff, and submit written reports to the Office of Aging for Alameda County in a timely manner specifically for clients who are being referred for Lanterman-Petris-Short certification. Psychologists will need to be licensed Ph.D candidates with 2 years of experience in diagnostic evaluation related work.

The task may require local travel to Napa State Hospital. Physician will need to have criminal justice clearance, should have own transportation and will be responsible for writing and submitting reports to the Office of Aging for Alameda County.

Consultants will be contacted by the Alameda County BHCS or the Office of Aging and will be expected to respond to request for service in 48 hours.

Compilation of the names will be on a continuing basis.
