SUBJECT: APPROVE FISCAL YEAR 2020 AUGMENTATION FOR NEW SERVICES-AS-NEEDED PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS AND AMENDMENTS FOR THE HOUSING SUPPORT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE HOUSING SUPPORT SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,219,343

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- A. Approve an augmentation to Master Contract No. 00002 for the 18 Procurement Contracts listed in Attachment A to provide housing subsidy payments, services coordination and other housing support services-as-needed (SAN) at 20 residential care facilities, with no change in the contract period for the 13 existing SAN contracts from 7/1/19 6/30/20, and 5 new SAN contracts with the contract period of 1/1/20 6/30/20, increasing the total pooled amount from \$2,360,657 to \$4,580,000 (\$2,219,343 increase):
- B. Delegate authority to the Agency Director or designee to execute the agreements and amendments subject to review and approval as to form by County Counsel, and submit to the Clerk of the Board executed copies for filing

### **DISCUSSION/SUMMARY**

The Housing Support Program (HSP) focuses on serving individuals with a long history of institutional care that are in need of intensive care and supervision supports from a licensed community care provider to help with their return to living in the community. This population has a higher risk of harm to self and others, inpatient and emergency mental health utilization, morbidity, mortality, institutionalization, and incarceration than the general population.

The HSP provides housing subsidy payments, services coordination and consultation, and training and technical support for board and care operators licensed through the California Department of Social Services Community Care Licensing division (CCL) and approved by CCL to serve adults living with serious mental illness (SMI) and who meet additional program criteria.

On July 9, 2019 your Board approved HSP SAN contracts and entered into agreements for this fiscal year in order to continue services prior to the release of a Request for Pre-Qualifications (RFPQ) (Item No. 9). On May 16, 2019, ACBH released a RFPQ to establish a pool of SAN contracts with eligible licensed adult residential facilities

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(ARF) and residential care facilities for the elderly (RCFE) operators. The RFPQ expanded the number of HSP SAN contractors and allowed for an increase in client choices for services and capacity.

Alameda County Behavioral Health (ACBH) is requesting approval of contract amendments to the 12 existing Services As Needed (SAN) providers listed in Attachment A to continue providing HSP services and requesting approval of five new Services-as-Needed (SAN) contracts with A-N-D Care Homes, Corazon Z. Pangilinan dba Amazing Grace Care Home, Gaffar Enterprises Inc. dba Lakeshore Residential Care, Koobamo LLC dba Good Shepard Vista, and Maria V Millare dba Lake Merritt Care Home to provide Housing Support Program (HSP) services as result of the RFPQ.

HSP contractors serve adults, 18 and over, as long as needed to support clients with care and supervision needs in a home environment and help clients participate and connect with community-based activities and social networks. The procurement also shifts the contracting approach from purchasing a specific number of beds from HSP providers to establishing three levels of care based on client need and increased reimbursement based on client's approved level of care and placement with an HSP provider.

Your Board's approval will increase capacity and client choice for services that reduce and prevent homelessness.

## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

ACBH released Request for Pre-Qualifications (RFPQ) No. 19-07 on May 16, 2019 to create a vendor pool of qualified bidders to provide HSP services through SAN contracts. The RFPQ was advertised for two months using the General Services Agency (GSA) advertising guidelines by posting on the ACBH and GSA websites. In addition, a courtesy email was sent to ACBH's contracted providers and other ACBH contracts via existing email distribution lists. ACBH hosted a question and answer session with interested bidders on May 29, 2019 in Oakland with attendance from over 18 agencies and subsequently posted the responses to questions asked on June 10, 2019 on ACBH and GSA websites.

ACBH received 18 bids for 20 board and care facilities to provide HSP services. Per GSA guidelines for a RFPQ, ACBH staff conducted a review of the bidder minimum qualifications, which 17 of the bidders met. One bidder Berkeley Place dba Casa de la Vida was disqualified as the bid did not meet minimum qualifications. The table below summarizes the results of this competitive bidding process and the recommendation to award SAN contracts to the 17 bidders included in Attachment A.

On September 19, 2019, Bidders were notified via email and certified mail of the recommendation for award. No bid protests were received. The bidders recommended to be included in the HSP SAN contract pool are very small, local sole proprietorships. HSP providers are selected based on the need for services in board & care settings. Two of the providers are Certified Small, Local and Emerging Businesses (SLEBs): Chika E. Ugbaja dba Great Expectation Residential Care Home (Certification No. 19-00060; Expiration Date: 6/30/20) and Corazon Z. Pangilinan – Amazing Grace Home (Certification No. 19-00053; Expiration Date: 6/3/20). The other providers received SLEB waivers that are all valid through 6/30/20. Please see Attachment A.

### **FINANCING**

Appropriations for these contracts are fully offset by the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) and Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG) funding already included in the FY 19-20 ACBH approved budget and included in the Homelessness Action Plan. There is no increase in net county cost as a result of your approval.

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# **VISION 2026 GOAL**

Housing subsidy payments, care coordination, and other housing support services related to board, and care facilities meet the 10x goal pathways of <u>Eliminating Homelessness</u> and <u>Healthcare for All</u> in support of the shared vision of a <u>Thriving and Resilient Population</u>.
