I. B. Background and Scope

The program model shall utilize Evidence Based Practices (EBPs) for treating EDs and shall offer individual therapy, group therapy, and family therapy as part of the treatment. All programs shall offer monitoring by a licensed dietician and medication support with a licensed prescriber/psychiatrist. Licensed staff providing telehealth services must be licensed in California. PHP and Residential programs shall have access to medical staff. Providers must be willing to work with third-party primary care providers and other medical staff, in addition to ACBH, in the discharge planning. The awarded Contractor(s) must possess valid licenses and a current fire clearance certificate.

RESPONSES TO BIDDER'S QUESTIONS

- Q1) Is "Obesity" included as a eating disorder?
- A1) As defined in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5), eating disorders include Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia Nervosa, Binge Eating Disorder, and Avoidant/Restrictive Food Intake Disorder.
