RESPONSES TO BIDDER'S QUESTIONS

Q1: Could you please clarify whether bidders must hold active CCL licensure for adult facilities at the time of submission (to meet Minimum Qualification I.D.1)? Alternatively, would evidence of a pending ARF application suffice, provided full licensure is granted by contract execution?

A1: Yes, Bidders must hold active CCL licensure at the time of bid submission in order to be considered. As stated in Section I. D. To be able to participate in this RFPQ, Bidders must meet the below Minimum Qualifications: 1. Demonstrate current ARF or RCFE licensure through CCL.
