

CANS/ANSA ToT: Training for Trainers

DESCRIPTION:

This one-day CANS/ANSA Trainer Training workshop is designed for individuals who wish to provide classroom-based training as well as coaching on the CANS/ANSA to staff within their own organizations. Participants will be presented a standard TCOM and CANS/ANSA Training curricula. Key concepts and skills will be practiced through small group discussions, exercises, and activities. Standard curriculum and other materials used during the workshop will be provided to support their work in helping trainees become certified in the use of the CANS/ANSA. Certified Trainers are required to re-certify annually to maintain their trainer status. Certified Trainer re-certification requires annual re-certification CANS/ANSA reliability of .80 or above. Attendance at the annual TCOM Conference once every 2-3 years is recommended.

- Articulate the TCOM framework and the CANS strategy.
- Describe Communimetrics and the 6 Key Principles of a Communimetric tool.
- Demonstrate mastery of the CANS/ANSA tool.
