Instructions for Registering on California—Alameda County Jurisdiction

Step 1: Go to: www.CANStraining.com

Step 2: Under “Create a New Account” click on “Register”

- Fill in the required fields:
 - Username (please create one)
 - First name
 - Last name
 - **Valid email address** (please use your work email address)
 - Create a password
 - Enter the password a second time to confirm



Step 3: Click “Next”

- Select the **Jurisdiction** “California—Alameda County” from the drop down box
- Select your **Agency** from the drop down box (**if you don't see your Agency, please contact Alex Jackson to have it added**)
- Enter the required fields:
 - Work/Phone number
 - ****External ID (This is your InSyst Staff ID#)****
- The rest of the fields are optional

Step 4: Click “Register”

Once registered, you can visit www.CANStraining.com at any time to refresh your CANS/ANSA information or take a practice vignette to refresh ratings a CANS/ANSA. We encourage you to take full advantage of the site.

Additional Information

- CANS/ANSA Certification is required for all Users (Clinicians, Senior Clinicians, Supervisor-Clinicians)
- To become certified to use the tool you must read a 1-page fictional vignette and rate items on the Alameda County CANS or ANSA. If you are certified in 1 version you are certified to administer all of them.
- You must score at least a .70 to pass certification.
- The certification is valid for one year and to continue using the CANS/ANSA tool you must recertify annually.
- There is no cost to Alameda County BHCS providers or need for a coupon. We got you covered!
