For children and adults we provide field based:

- Prevention and early intervention services
- Telephone crisis intervention, information and referrals
- · Mobile crisis intervention
- Assessment for hospitalization
- Diversion to other less restrictive settings
- Post crisis follow up
- Care coordination & linkage

Crisis Services Programs use mobile crisis teams to respond to individuals experiencing a mental health crisis and/or who are at risk of harming themselves or someone else due to a mental illness.



Crisis Services is staffed by Peer Specialists, Family Partners and Behavioral Health Clinicians who provide services in the field. Our mission is to assess and connect individuals with the services they need when they need them to live safely in the community.
