Alameda County Proposition 47 Local Advisory Committee Community Representative Application

The Alameda County Proposition 47 Local Advisory Committee (LAC) seeks formerly incarcerated and/or "systems-impacted" individuals to serve as Community Representatives on the Committee.

Proposition 47 Grant Overview

In June 2017, the California Board of State and Community Corrections awarded Alameda County a \$6 million grant to provide criminal justice system-involved individuals with mental health services, substance use disorder treatment, and housing assistance resources. In 2019, Alameda County received a second \$6 million grant. Alameda County is now receiving a third \$6 million grant to continue providing these services and to create a diversion program for the next three years, from September 2022 until June 2026.

Local Advisory Committee Overview

The LAC was originally formed in January 2017 to advise the development of the project proposal. The LAC now meets on a quarterly basis to advise the ongoing implementation of the County Programs.

The LAC consists of representatives from public agencies that participate in the Community Corrections Partnership² and up to five Community Representatives who are formerly incarcerated and/or systems-impacted, who also reflect the diversity and culture of the community.

Local Advisory Committee Member Responsibilities

LAC members are required to attend quarterly evening meetings (usually held at 1111 Jackson Street, Oakland; currently virtual due to COVID-19). The next meeting is scheduled for 5:30-7:00 p.m. on **April 24, 2023**. Member terms expire at the end of the third grant on June 1st, 2026.

Selection Process and Timeline

There are up to five vacancies for Community Representative. The current LAC members will review applications from all qualified parties and vote for their preferred candidate(s) in a closed session meeting in January, 2023.
