Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Services (ACBH) would like to invite you to join in <u>ACBH Opioid Settlement</u>—<u>Listening Sessions</u>. Opioid Settlement refers to the legal resolution of suits filed by the state, County of Alameda and cities against opioid manufacturers, distributors, and prescribers for their role in fueling the opioid epidemic. Settlement resulted in pharmaceuticals and other entities providing fiscal settlement to state jurisdictions to address opioid crisis. It is estimated that ACBH will receive approximately \$40M to address opioid and substance use disorders in our county.

The goals of the sessions are to review current opioid data, opportunities for intervention, settlement funding updates and ACBH's short and long-term program planning including plans to release Substance Use Continuum of Care innovation grants. In addition, the listening sessions will be an opportunity for stakeholders to give additional feedback to ACBH on usage of the settlement funds.
