As many are already aware, our system is less than one month from our *SmartCare Go-Live* date of July **1, 2023**. To that end, our SmartCare Implementation Team continues to actively work with the vendor, *Streamline*, to prepare for Go-Live readiness. The SmartCare system will replace the legacy billing system (*InSyst*), fee-for-service (FFS) managed care system (*eCura*), and Microsoft Access Databases.

To provide increased stability given the status of the SmartCare Implementation, ACBH will be updating provider Interim Contracts to <u>include</u> provisions for monthly actual cost reimbursement for the first **quarter of Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 (July 2023 – September 2023)**. Contract settlement terms will remain consistent per your organization's contract. Some programs will require an alternative method in lieu of line-item actual cost submission for first quarter reimbursement, and as a result, ACBH Contracts office will address those specific provider contract provisions accordingly.

The Interim Contract Rate Sheets will include a footnote to reflect these updates. In order to ensure regular updates and instructions are provided to our provider community, future communications are planned and will include additional details (i.e., footnote information and invoicing procedures).
