

## **Behavioral Health Clinicians II or Equivalent: Opportunity for Overtime**

*Help support the mental health of adults incarcerated at Santa Rita Jail in Dublin.*

Overtime is available with Adult Forensic Behavioral Health for the classification of **Behavioral Health Clinician II**. Behavioral Health Clinicians will **receive overtime pay PLUS an additional 15% footnote.**

Overtime is available for all shifts, including overnight shifts (11:30pm - 7:00am), upon request. **Please note, overnight shifts are strictly voluntary.**

Please Note: Overtime must be approved by your immediate supervisor and not interfere with regular job duties. Staff selected for overtime must also pass a comprehensive background check conducted by Alameda County Sherriff.

**Job duties:** Duties include individual mental health services, screening and assessment, and crisis intervention.

**Hours of Operation:** 7 days a week, 365 days per year  
7:00 am – 11:30 pm daily  
Includes holidays  
*Flexible scheduling. All shifts available.*
