Behavioral Health Clinicians who participate will **receive overtime pay for the critical support that they provide to the clients and families in need of our help through the Juvenile Justice Center.**

Overtime is available for shifts seven-days a week during the hours of 8:00am – 8:00pm.

<u>Please Note:</u> Overtime must be approved by your immediate supervisor and not interfere with regular job duties. Individuals must pass a background check to work overtime.

Job duties: Duties may include assessment, individual mental health services, behavioral health groups, crisis support, and consultation.
