Tobacco Prevention & Treatment Training Program

LifeLong Medical Care's Tobacco Prevention & Treatment Training Program is working with ACBH to help providers strengthen their tobacco use intervention initiatives.

Trainings

The program provides training on topics such as:

- → Strategies for integrating tobacco dependence interventions into treatment programs
- → Successfully **implementing and integrating the ACBH Tobacco Policy** within treatment programs
- → **Updating intake workflows** to include tobacco use screening
- → **Using Nicotine Replacement Therapy** (NRT) and other evidence-based treatment modalities
- → Complying with California law regarding tobacco use screening and treatment
- → Implementing peer-led tobacco recovery presentations and support groups within consumer-led agencies
- → Referring patients to Kick It California for free recovery assistance
- → Creating a stigma-free environment where patients feel empowered to recover from commercial tobacco and nicotine dependence

Tobacco Treatment Specialist (TTS) Training

Our program is excited to offer the **Tobacco Treatment Specialist (TTS) training.** This training is an opportunity to increase the knowledge base of staff who deliver or have an interest in delivering tobacco treatment services.

Participants should expect to gain in-depth knowledge of motivational interviewing, pharmacotherapy for tobacco use disorder, and best practices for assessment and treatment. Successful completion of this training is one of the primary qualifications for the National Certificate in Tobacco Treatment Practice.

The training consists of:

- 1. A 10-hour online portion, to be completed prior to the following session
- 2. A 3-day training session
- 3. An online exam, to be completed after the final session

Through ACBH, the Tobacco Treatment Training Program is **fully funding the TTS training for 15 substance use disorder counselors** working within ACBH provider organizations.
