Stipend Details -

- Maximum Award: Up to \$6,000
- Maximum Internship Hours: 720 hours
- Pro-Rated Payment: Stipend amounts are adjusted based on actual hours completed.

Example:

- 720 hours = \$6,000
- 360 hours (half) = \$3,000
