In March 2025, the Asian American Native Hawaiian Pacific Islander (AANHPI) Committee with Office of Ethnic Services (OES), launched a mini-grant process to award four local organizations with funding to support behavioral health program/projects serving Alameda County's AANHPI community. The AANHPI Committee received 27 outstanding applications. With the generous help of 4 ACBHD colleagues, 4 organizations were each selected for a \$20,000 mini-grants. A 5th organization was awarded a smaller grant of \$15,000.
