

AANHPI MINI GRANTS AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT

Alameda County Behavioral Health Department (ACBHD) Office of Ethnic Services (OES) with the AANHPI Advisory Committee granted four \$25,000 mini-grants to fund a 9- month behavioral health program/project serving the AANHPI community. Grant funding will be used for new or to support existing programs focusing on one of the following categories below;

- a.) Youth internship program and stipends
- b.) Behavioral health awareness campaign
- c.) Cultural programs that enhance wellness.

These mini grants are intended to support CBO capacity to deliver quality services to clients and/or potential clients who are at risk for mental health or/and substance use disorder issues. An additional 5th organization was awarded a smaller grant of \$15,000.
