Subject: New Resource: ACBHD Timely Access Data Collection Requirements and Definitions

This memo is to inform providers of the publication of a new reference document that describes the timely access requirements for SMHS and DMC-ODS services.

Background

Per <u>BHIN 25-013 2025 Network Certification Requirements</u>, Behavioral Health Plans must demonstrate compliance with the State's standards for access to services, including network adequacy and timely access standards.

Resources

ACBHD has developed multiple resources to assist providers in understanding and complying with the timely access requirements, including several recorded training modules that are posted on the QA <u>Training</u> page on the Provider website.

A new resource titled <u>ACBHD Timely Access Data Collection Requirements and Definitions</u> was recently published in section 5 of the <u>QA Manual</u>. This new resource replaces the *Timeliness Access Data Collection Definitions FY25-26* document and is a more comprehensive reference, including not only the timely access data collection definitions, but information related to scope, specific data collection requirements and scenarios related to timely access data collection.
