RE: New billing code: 577: Intensive Care Coordination

Billing code 577 may now be used by select Providers approved by the Children's System of Care—ACBHCS.

This code entitled "Intensive Care Coordination" may only be used for participation (in person or teleconference) in a KTA subclass member's Child and Family Team (CFT) Meeting--inclusive of documentation and travel time.

See enclosed "Documentation & Billing for CFT Meeting—for Non-KTA Designated Providers" instructions.

If you are working with a KTA subclass member who is being served with Intensive Care Coordination at a KTA Provider Program*, the Intensive Care Coordinator may invite you to participate in the client's CFT meetings. Your attendance and participation in CFT meetings must be billed with the ICC code.

If you are working with a client whom you believe to be a KTA subclass member who is not yet receiving Intensive Care Coordination, speak with the client's Child Welfare Worker. The Child Welfare Worker can make a referral for KTA subclass services if the client is eligible.
