Subject: Notice of Adverse Benefit Determination (NOABD) for Medi-Cal

Beneficiaries Policy, Procedure, Training, and Templates

Effective Immediately

ACBH Administration would like to present the <u>NOABD policy</u> to all Behavioral Health Plan (BHP) Medi-Cal programs. This policy replaces the former Notices of Action for Medi-Cal Beneficiaries and will bring our BHP into compliance with the CMS Final Rule federal grievance and appeal system requirements per <u>MHSUDS</u> Information Notice No. 18-010E.

ACBH, including contracted agencies, are required to issue the appropriate NOABD template in a timely and complete manner for adverse benefit determinations rendered to Medi-Cal beneficiaries. Contractors are required to submit copies of issued NOABDs to the ACBH Quality Assurance (QA) Office.

The criteria for determining issuance as well as the process of issuing and reporting NOABDs will be further demonstrated and explained in the following training sessions: Training Flyer
