SUBJECT: Problem List Improvements in Clinician's Gateway (CG)

The purpose of this memorandum is to announce the implementation of Problem List improvements in the Clinician's Gateway (CG) Mental Health Services (MHS) and Substance Use Disorder (SUD) environments. CG is ACBH's Electronic Health Record that is utilized by many County providers. **This memo is informational only.**

CG Updates: The following improvements have been made in the CG MHS and SUD environments:

- 1. **Refinement of Drop-Down List.** Problems displayed in the drop-down are now only those which are allowed, as determined by the scope of practice of the user and by Department of HealthCare Services (DHCS). Codes which are not allowed are not displayed.
- 2. **Revision of** List of Allowed F Codes. "Licensed" staff has changed to "Professional BH" staff in the title and header.
- Addition of <u>Allowed T and Z Psychosocial Codes</u> for use by Professional BH staff (codes as allowed by DHCS). MHS and SUD codes are also available to Professional BH staff in both environments.
- 4. Addition of "By Report" Button for use by Professional BH staff. This option allows Professional BH staff to add any problem that is allowed for the medical staff. Medical problems identified by the beneficiary and/or other significant support person can be added to the list using this option. An icon (raised hand) will appear on the Problem List to indicate that the problem was "By Report".
- Revision of Problem List Guidelines.
 - a. CNS and Pharmacist have been added to the grid of which codes are available to MD/Nurse scope of practice.
 - b. An Archive Button will be launched next week. This button can be used by all staff to remove a problem that was erroneously added to the list. This option should not be used to close a problem that has been resolved or being deferred.
