The purpose of this memo is to notify ACBH providers of updates to staff designation and professional suffixes resulting from CalAIM payment reform changes and ACBH's implementation of the SmartCare billing system.

Information about the Changes

As part of the California Department of Healthcare Services's (DHCS) Payment Reform changes effective 7/1/23 and ACBH's transition to SmartCare, there are a number of changes to Speciality Mental Health Services (SMHS) and Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) provider types. Both SmartCare and the e-form used to request SmartCare access have been updated to reflect these changes.

The allowable provider types between SMHS and DMC-ODS mostly overlap, but there are some notable differences as specified in the far left column of the table below.

Mental Health Students in SMHS

Individuals actively enrolled in graduate educational mental health programs are considered students. These are individuals who are not registered with the corresponding licensing board. With the roll out of CalAIM Payment Reform, Medi-Cal guidance, as described in the DHCS SMHS Billing Manual (v 1.4), indicates that students should use taxonomy codes based on their education, training, and experience within the Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialist (MHRS), Other Qualified Provider, and peer specialist disciplines. These changes prevent ACBH from claiming for psychotherapy services (individual/family/group) provided by students.

To minimize the impact of this new requirement on providers and beneficiaries, ACBH will continue to reimburse contractors for individual and group psychotherapy services provided by students for the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2023-24 (July 1, 2023 – September 30, 2023). After the first quarter, based on DHCS guidance, ACBH will provide further updates. See <u>ACBH memo</u> dated 7/6 for more details.

Mental Health Students in DMC-ODS²

Recent legislation (<u>CA Assembly Bill 1860, Ch. 523</u> and H&SC 11833) allows for individuals enrolled in mental health graduate programs to provide services in DMC-ODS. ACBH has sought additional clarification from DHCS regarding some outstanding questions on implementation of this change. As soon as we get clarification, ACBH will work towards allowing these individuals to claim for DMC-ODS services.

Information for Clinician's Gateway Users

New Clinician's Gateway (CG) accounts will use this new set of professional suffixes starting 7/1/23. Existing staff suffixes will be migrated from CG-InSyst into CG-SmartCare (CG-SC) and will be used in CG-SC e-signatures. The suffixes imported into CG-SC may not align with the new suffixes in the SmartCare billing system. To fix this, submit a CG Staff Authorization e-form for an individual (or by attaching a spreadsheet of desired updates for multiple staff to the single request).
