CG is being updated to respond to new requirements from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), MediCare, SmartCare and to streamline staff data entry tasks. A Release Note has been published and is posted on the Clinician's Gateway page of the Alameda County Behavioral Health Department (ACBHD) provider website, in the Manuals and Documentations section.

"Minutes to Units Conversion" changes have already been installed. Changes to "Procedure Codes" and "SUD Specific Changes" will be launched on Monday 7/1/24, and the rest of the changes will be implemented on 7/8/24.

Additionally, the <u>New Primary Codes for FY24-25</u> document was created as a reference guide for providers to track procedure code changes effective July 1, 2024. This document is also posted on the <u>Clinician's Gateway</u> page of the ACBHD provider website, in the Manuals and Documentations section.
