Subject: Updates to CG Problem List Functionality

Purpose

The purpose of this memo is to provide information about recent updates to Clinician's Gateway (CG) to the *Problem List's* functionality.

Problem List Functionality Updates

Updates to FY26-27 ICD-10-CM

The diagnoses and codes that populate the problem list have been updated to include all HIPAA-compliant ICD-10-CM codes provided by DHCS/CMS for FY26-27.¹

Updates to Scope of Practice

The Problem List's scope of practice validation logic has been updated as follows:

- All clinicians with the scope of practice to diagnose now have access to all HIPAA-compliant ICD-10-CM codes (without override).
- All staff can use codes Z55-Z65.

Previously, physical health clinicians could use all codes, behavioral health clinicians could use codes in the DSM, and all staff could use codes Z55-Z65. With this increased access, it is the responsibility of the diagnosing clinician to only use codes based on their discipline's scope of practice and their training and knowledge.

Problems Identified by the Client or a Significant Support Person

The problem list override function, allowing providers to add items outside of their scope of practice when the problem is identified by the client and/or significant support person, has been fixed. It should now be working as intended.

To use the override feature, click on the checkbox next to *Identified by beneficiary and/or significant support person* prior to searching for a diagnosis outside your disciplines' scope of practice.
