

CLINICAL DOCUMENTATION Training for the SHORT-TERM RESIDENTIAL THERAPEUTIC PROGRAM (STRTP)

Target Audience: Alameda County Behavioral Health (ACBH) contracted providers who provide Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) at Short-term Residential Therapeutic Programs (STRTPs). Provider QA leads, clinical supervisors, and clinical staff are all strongly recommended to attend.

Description: In accordance with the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Interim STRTP Regulations (Version 2), this training will address ACBH & Medi-Cal documentation standards for STRTPs, including mental health assessment, admission statement, treatment plan, progress note, and transition determination plan requirements. The training will also address recent changes under the Family First Prevention Services ACT (FFSPA) as they pertain to STRTPs.

consultation on documentation, quality management and continuous quality improvement activities.

- 1. Identify the eleven (11) required elements of a STRTP client chart.
- Identify the sequence of documentation and timeliness expectations for the following clinical records/services: STRTP Mental Health Assessment and Emergency Placement Assessment, Admission Statement, CANS and PSC-35, Treatment Plan, Progress Notes, Medication Review, Clinical Review, and Transition Determination Plan.
- 3. Identify and describe the minimum required elements of the following: STRTP Mental Health Assessment and Emergency Placement Assessment, Admission Statement, Treatment Plan, SMHS Progress Notes and Daily Mental Health Notes, Medication Review, Clinical Review, and Transition Determination Plan.
- 4. Describe three (3) major changes as a result of the Family First Prevention Services Act (FFSPA) and how they impact STRTPs.
- 5. Define implicit bias and identify three (3) strategies for reducing it in the context of your work.
