


INSYST Client and Service Information (CSI) Assessment Record Data Screens Onboarding Instructions

The following step by step guide is provided to assist you in transitioning from using the e-Form to using the new CSI Assessment Record Data screens in INSYST for data tracking.

Step 1. Access

Special access is required to use the needed screens in InSYST. To receive access, please complete the InSyst User Authorization form and select "Yes" for the question "Does User Require access to CSI Assessment Screens?"





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Step 2. Training

All training materials, including two recorded training programs related to Network Adequacy requirements and use of the CSI Timeliness Assessment screens, can be found on the ACBH Provider Website, Quality Assurance Training page, under Training Handouts and Resources, section titled:

Network Adequacy Certification Tool (NACT) – Timely Access Client Service Information (CSI) Assessment Record Data Submission Training for Community Based Organizations.
